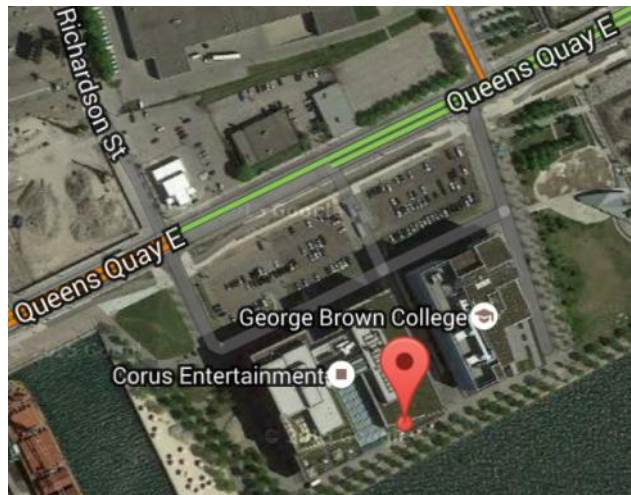


Countdown to the Northmount Gala!
