## 2015-2016 Northmount Knights Athletic Recap

The 2015-2016 school year was another strong one for our athletic teams. We were able to field 16 teams in 9 different sports, with the majority of our boys having an opportunity to play. The year began with our volleyball and basketball seasons. These teams did exceptionally well all season long, and finished in 3<sup>rd</sup> place and 5<sup>th</sup> place, respectively.

The Fall also saw Northmount field a cross country team with over 50 participants. Everyone who participated enjoyed themselves and truly represented Northmount School with great respect. This was highlighted by a 3<sup>rd</sup> place finish by Patrick.

The 2015-2016 school year also witnessed the introduction of three new junior teams. Northmount was able to field a U12 basketball team, a U10 ball hockey team, and a school wide golf team. These teams were able to compete in their respective sports at a high level, and showed great promise. We are excited for these boys to grow in these sports.

In Term Two, Northmount teams competed in ball hockey, badminton, and curling. It was an extremely busy time for school sports and also came with a great deal of success. In ball hockey, the U10, U12, and U14 teams all were eliminated in the semi-finals. Each team had a successful tournament, leaving with positive records.

At the Donalda curling facility many students was able to try curling for the first time. The curling team practiced weekly in preparation for their SSAF competition. The Northmount Knights curling team went undefeated throughout the curling tournament and was able to secure Northmount's first-ever curling banner.

In badminton, 12 students from Northmount were registered to play in the regional qualifier. Of those 12, 11 athletes qualified themselves for the SSAF final tournament. Each student represented Northmount extremely well at this tournament, and there were six students in particular who found great success. Congratulations to Minh (1<sup>st</sup> place boys singles) and Matthew (2<sup>nd</sup> place boys singles). William and Russell (4<sup>th</sup> place boys doubles) and Matthew and Mitchell (1<sup>st</sup> place boys doubles), representing Northmount in the U14, built off successful tournaments last year to come up with their victories this year.

Last but not least, Grades 1 through 8 had the opportunity to compete in the SSAF Track and Field Championships, U10 and U14 outdoor soccer tournaments, and softball games with other SSAF schools. At the release time of this Wednesday File, not all results were in, but it was an extremely busy and fun filled end to the athletic season.
